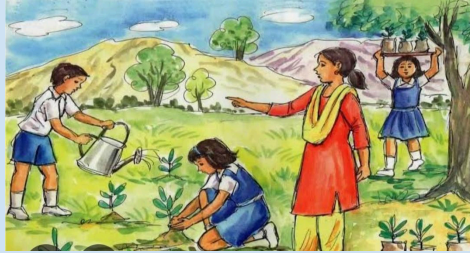

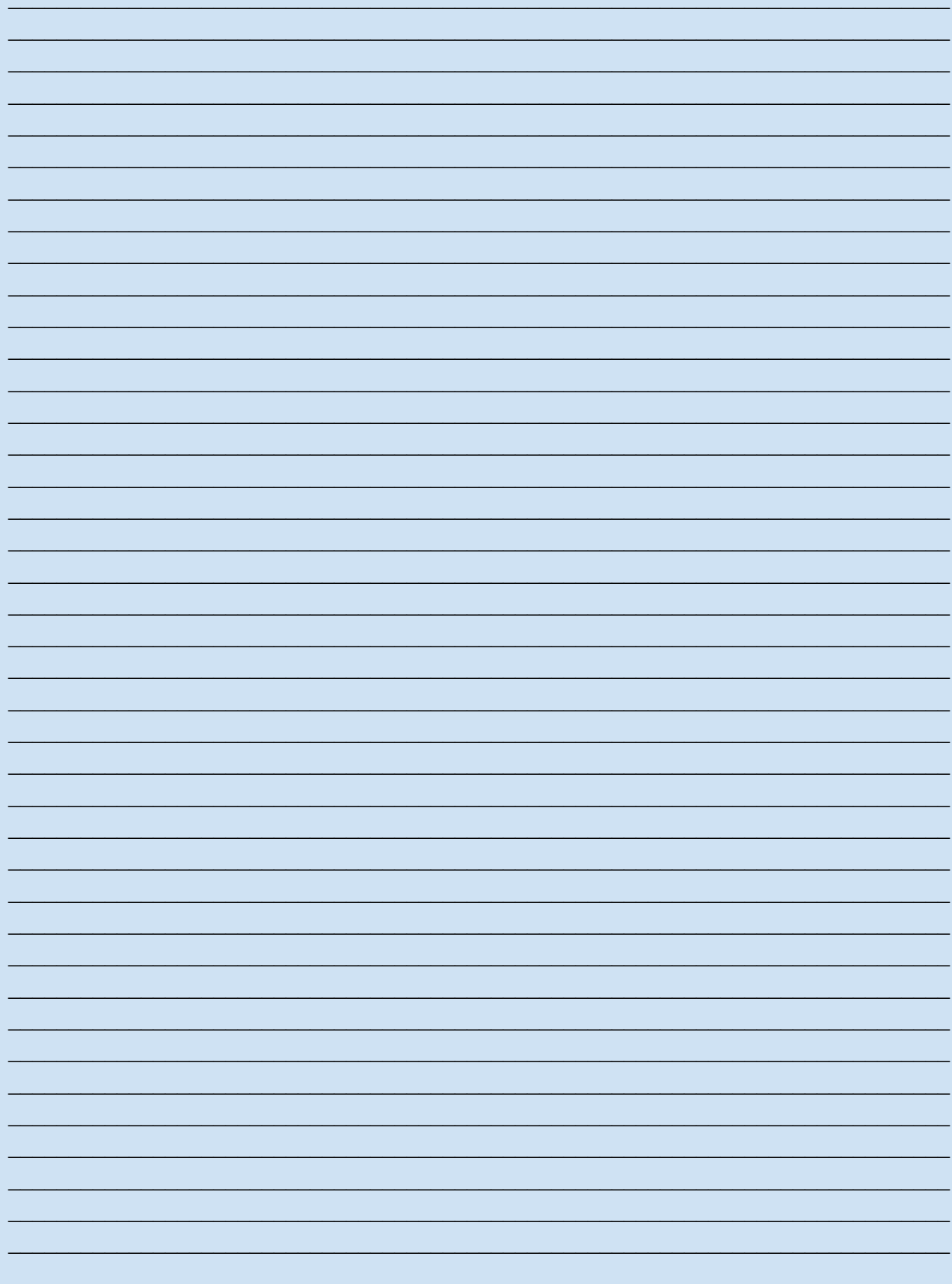

जल प्रदूषण आज के समय की एक गंभीर पर्यावरणीय समस्या है। यह तब होता है जब नदियों, झीलों, तालाबों और समुद्रों में हानिकारक रसायनों, कचरे, प्लास्टिक और विषैले पदार्थों का मिश्रण होता है। इससे न केवल जलजीवों को हानि पहुँचती है, बल्कि मनुष्यों को भी अनेक बीमारियाँ हो सकती हैं जैसे टाइफाइड, हैजा और हैपेटाइटिस। जल प्रदूषण का मुख्य कारण उद्योगों से निकलने वाले अपशिष्ट, कृषि में प्रयुक्त रासायनिक उर्वरक और कीटनाशक, तथा घरेलू नालियों से बहने वाला गंदा पानी है। जल प्रदूषण को रोकने के लिए कई उपाय किए जा सकते हैं। सबसे पहले, उद्योगों को चाहिए कि वे अपने अपशिष्ट जल को शुद्ध करके ही जल स्रोतों में प्रवाहित करें। किसानों को भी जैविक खाद और प्राकृतिक कीटनाशकों का प्रयोग बढ़ाना चाहिए। नगरपालिकाओं को यह सुनिश्चित करना चाहिए कि घरेलू जल शुद्धिकरण संयंत्रों से होकर गुजरे। साथ ही, आम जनता को भी जल स्रोतों को साफ रखने का संकल्प लेना चाहिए और प्लास्टिक का उपयोग कम करना चाहिए। स्वच्छ भारत अभियान का इससे संबंध है। इसके लिए किए गए प्रयास इस दिशा में सहायक हो सकते हैं।
